Easy Brunswick Stew

- 1 large onion, chopped
- 1 celery rib, chopped
- 1 large green pepper, chopped
- 1 cup frozen sliced okra
- 4 cups frozen hash brown potatoes
- 3/4 pound mustard based barbeque shredded pork
- 1 cup chopped cooked chicken
- 1 (14.5 oz) can diced tomatoes
- 1 (15 oz) can tomato sauce
- 1 (15.5) can whole corn with peppers, drained
- 1(15.5) can lima beans, drained
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

Combine all ingredients in a 5 qt. slow cooker, cover and cook on high for 6.5 hours. I add extra barbeque sauce. 1/2 cup maybe.
