The meeting was called to order by Ginny Frame at 9:30 am. 41 members and 2 visitors were present. Katya Holden, who will be doing the class this afternoon, was introduced. Ginny asked for feed back concerning the room arrangement of the meeting room.

August meeting minutes were approved as printed in the newsletter. Treasurers report was given. The prior balance was \$9,631.68 with an income of \$30.00 and expenses of \$982.11-class expenses and hospitality reimbursement, leaving a balance of \$8,679.57.
