A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

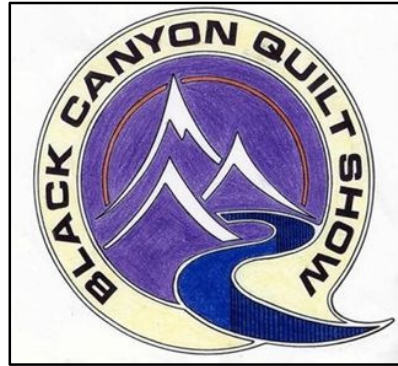

Seatbelt Covers For the Boutique

If you would like to make padded seatbelt covers at the Boutique Sew-In on April 14, here's what you need for one:

- a) two pieces of fabric (either coordinating or matching) cut 6 1/2" x 8"
- b) two pieces of batting cut 6 1/4" x 7 1/2" - two pieces makes it a little more padded. The batting can be cotton, polyester, or a blend.

I will have several yards of the sew-on velcro, but if you want to bring some that's fine! It takes just 6" for one seat belt cover.
