


## General Rules 2022

Deadline for quilt entries is **June 1, 2022**

1. Submit entry forms to: Black Canyon Quilt Show, Inc.; PO Box 2053; Montrose, CO 81402 or at your guild meeting before June 1, 2022. **PLEASE FILL OUT THE FORM COMPLETELY!!**
2. **Attach a photo of your quilt to the back of the entry form.** (The quilt does not have to be complete in the picture.) We will use the photos to help with pleasing arrangement of quilts at the show.
3. You may enter **only two quilts in the same category.** The Black Canyon Quilt Show should **not have displayed your entry in the past.** The Black Canyon Quilt Show **cannot accept a framed entry.**
4. **All quilts must have a 4" hanging sleeve.** You should place the sleeve at the top of the quilt.
5. Cut two or three 3" squares of muslin for labels. (**Please use safety pins to attach all labels.**)
  - a. Print name of entrant on a square and pin to the lower left corner (when looking at the back of the quilt) **ONLY** if the entrant's name is not on a sewn label.
  - b. **BOLDLY** print your **entry number** and **name** on a square and pin to the top of the pillowcase that carries your entry. A Show volunteer will assign your entry number(s) and will communicate it to you by email or phone after June 1.
  - c. **BOLDLY** print your entry number on a square along with 1) **type of quilting** (Long/Mid-arm, domestic machine, computer aided, or hand; **and** 2) **non-professional or professional quilting.** This information will match information from your entry form. Pin to the front of your quilt, lower left hand corner (when looking at the front of the quilt).

6. Liability Insurance is the sole responsibility of each quilt owner. Black Canyon Quilt Show, Inc. does not assume liability for loss or damage of any nature to your quilt. The sponsors of the Black Canyon Quilt Show will handle your quilt with the utmost care.
7. Black Canyon Quilt Show reserves the right to move your quilt to a more appropriate category.
8. Black Canyon Quilt Show volunteers must receive all show entries at the Montrose Pavilion between 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM on Wednesday, July 13, 2022. Items must be in individually labeled pillowcases. You must pick up your quilt(s) between 4:30 and 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 17, 2022. We will require the signature of the person picking up the quilt during check out.

### Categories

**Pieced\***: Quilts made from pieces of fabric sewn together by hand or machine

**Mixed Techniques\***: Quilts that combine applique and piecing. Whole cloth, yo-yo's or fully embroidered quilts fit in this category

**Hand Applique**: Quilts with pieces of fabric which are hand sewn onto a background fabric to form a design. At least 75% of the surface is applique.

**Machine Applique\***: Quilts with pieces of fabric which are sewn or fused onto a background fabric to form a design. At least 75% of the surface is applique.

**Modern Quilt**: Functional, often bold colored quilts with minimalism, asymmetry, expansive negative space, and/or alternate grid work.

**Art Quilt**: Layered fibers of original pattern incorporating experimentation with textile manipulation, color, texture, and/or a diversity of mixed media. One person must complete all work.

**Kit**: A quilt of any technique where the pattern and fabrics were purchased as a unit to then be assembled

**Group Quilt**: Quilts made by 3 or more people, any technique

**Challenge**: Theme "Silver Threads." Silver must be used in the quilt (fabric, quilting, threads, or embellishments). Perimeter not more than 120". One person must complete all work.

**Youth**: Age 18 or younger. The youth must construct the top.

**\*Judges will look at quilts in these categories in groups based on quilt size and the number of entrants in each category. Small – up to 120" perimeter; Medium – 121" to 260" perimeter; Large – 261" to 480" perimeter**

### Awards

For each category, there may be 3 ribbons awarded by the judges: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

**Machine Quilting – Non-Professional**

**Machine Quilting – Professional**: "Professional" means the quilt was quilted by a person who quilts for any means of gain.

**Computer Aided Quilting**

**Domestic Machine Quilting**

**Hand Quilting**

**Youth** are encouraged to have their quilts judged. Each youth quilter will receive a ribbon for participation in the show.

The judges may present special awards for:

**Best of Show**

**Best New Quilter**

**Judge's Choice**: judge(s) will select a favorite quilt.

**CQC or NACQA Award of Excellence**

**President's Choice** – President will select a favorite quilt

**Viewer's Choice**: Quilt show viewers will choose this quilt during the show.

**Mayor's Choice**: Montrose mayor's favorite quilt.

**Quilts by nationally recognized quilters are welcome for exhibit but will not be judged.**
