Quilters Wisdom

Check your seam allowance guide to make sure it is $\frac{1}{4}$ " before you begin each new project.

After you lay out your quilt top pieces, take a black-and-white photo on your phone to make sure your lights, mediums and darks are in the best placement.

Quilters Tips
