If you want to participate, here's a suggested list of what to do ahead of time,

and what to bring to the meeting.

Before you come: Your Sewing Machine prep.

Take time to remove any lint build-up from your bobbin area.

Put in a new needle (if needed.) (a 90 14 is a good one)

Put on your quilting foot.

Bring with you:

Your machine, prepped and set up with good thread, and a full bobbin or 2.

I will have a stack of quilt block sandwiches ready for everyone to practice on.

Bring those with you if you took notes of Pam Grow's Free Motion Quilting program in March. This will be a good time to practice some of the designs she shared. Looking forward to it! See you then.

October's Quilt Program will be

A demonstration of the Watercolor Technique.

It uses a 2" grid of interfacing with 2" squares of fabric, usually florals, creating a lovely collage.
